Class 1 Warm Up

Prelim 1(2006) /Novice 28 (2008) % Class – you may ride any or both test in this Class. Highest % wins (if you ride 2 tests you pay the entry fee twice).

Class 2 Team & Individual County Qualifier

Test : Prelim 14 (2006) – for all riders

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count.

All team riders also automatically count for individual placings

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse/rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horses with 49 BD points or less, gained at any level. Downgraded horses may not compete in Prelim restricted classes.

Class 2 Novice 27 (2007) – individual county qualifier only.

The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to riders not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level and horses with 49 BD points or less.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points

**Entry Fee** - £15 per class (includes First Aid).
