The top two teams must be from different schools.

Class 5 1m Team & Individual County Qualifier
Team & Individual Qualifier for the County Finals at Bury Farm April 2019
& Qualifier for the Hickstead Elite 1m Team Championship.

The top 2 teams will qualify to compete at Hickstead (date to be confirmed for 2019)
Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. 1 round, single phase.



HICKSTEAD

Class 6ab 1.10m Individual County Qualifier. Class split into a) horses and b) ponies
for the County Finals at Bury Farm April 2019
& Qualifier for the Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Championships.

The top 2 horses & ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead (date to be confirmed for 2019)

Individual 1.10m qualifiers for horses and ponies (separate sections)
Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section.
1 round single phase.

All classes will be run as a BS Single Phase Competition (course in two parts with second part timed). The competitor is to jump both parts unless eliminated. Three refusals will result in elimination. Faults to be accumulated.

- All team members will automatically compete for individual prizes aswell.
- Entry fee: **£18** per round per competitor. Late entries £3 extra if space.
- Entry fee includes First Aid.

Prizes: Individual rosettes 1st – 6th place in each class.
Team rosettes 1st – 6th in each class.
